## #1 - Joyce Peachey Lind ordained



On September 10, 2023, the Community Mennonite congregation ordained Pastor Joyce for pastoral ministry within Mennonite Church USA. Since September 2020, she has been serving as one of the pastoral team at CMC, having previously received a ministerial credential of license toward ordination. Licensing is usually issued for a minimum of a two-year period for the purpose of testing a pastor's inner and outer call



to ministry. Joyce's licensing period lasted about 3 years, mostly because of pandemic interference. Following discernment with Joyce and the church council at its April 13, 2023 meeting, a recommendation

was submitted to Allegheny Mennonite Conference for Joyce to be ordained.



At the ordination service, Beth Ranck Yoder brought the message. The service also included a special children's time with a Q&A led by interim pastor Luann Yutzy, where children could weigh in on what they thought pastoral ministry was about. Children also provided a blessing of flowers.

Congratulations and blessings to Joyce and the CMC community as they embrace this chapter of ministry together.
